

CUEnet Open Schedule

Beginning in January of 2026, CUEnet is moving to an open schedule in which **every course will be available each month**. The goal of this change is to allow students to design a schedule that is most convenient for them. The open schedule enables each student to choose the month in which their studies begin, as well as allowing them to pause their studies should their personal circumstances require it without having to wait months for their next course to be offered again. It is our hope that this change makes CUEnet's Colloquy Program even more accessible to teachers who wish to strengthen their service to their students and the Church.

The courses must still be taken one at a time and in order:

1. Old Testament
2. New Testament
3. History of Theology
4. Christian Doctrine
5. Lutheran Confessions
6. Varieties of Belief
7. Lutheran Teacher 1*
8. Lutheran Teacher 2*

* LT1 & 2 must be taken in two consecutive months.

Please note:

- This is a pilot program which may be discontinued at any time. Should the open schedule be discontinued, current students will be allowed to continue taking courses for as long as they are taking them consecutively one month after another. If a student pauses their studies, they will become subject to the schedule that exists at that time.
- Courses will continue to begin on the first of each month and end on the 25th.
- CUEnet reserves the right to limit enrollment in any particular course based on demand for that course and mentor availability. We do not anticipate doing so.
